In Northern California, 11 000 firemen were mobilised on the ground. Four firefighters were burned in the second degree and remain hospitalised. In this region under severe drought, fires ravaged 534 km<sup>2</sup> which is five times the size of Paris. The flames now threaten the Californian vineyards.
